



Dear Glenwood Parent/Guardian,

Every school in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts has a school council. Ours is called SIMCO or Glenwood Elementary School Improvement Council. It is comprised of at least four parent representatives, equal number of staff and administrative representatives and at least one community or non-parent representative.

SIMCO meets once a month and assists the principal in creating a budget and creating and implementing a school improvement plan. The plan is then submitted and reviewed for approval by the Wachusett Regional School Committee. The first SIMCO meeting will be held on **Wednesday, October 19, 2011 at 4:00 pm** in the Glenwood Elementary School office conference room. At that meeting, future meeting days and times will be determined based on the group's availability.
